Dear Taxpayer:

We have reviewed your application for a disproportionate exemption certificate issued, the following requirements must be met:

You do not qualify for nonprofit exemption under Tenn. Code Ann. Section 67-6-322.

Please provide the following documentation: ~~documentation was not submitted with your application.~~

Your organization is an out-of-state 501(c)(3) exempt entity. Tenn. Code Ann. Section 67-6-322(b) allows you to provide a copy of your 501(c)(3) exemption document to Tennessee suppliers for exemption from sales and use tax. A separate Tennessee tax exemption certificate will not be issued to your organization.

You are an entity of the Tennessee state government, a county or municipal government within Tennessee, or the Federal government. You will use a generic "Government Certificate of Exemption" without a specific assigned exemption number. A separate Tennessee tax exemption certificate will not be issued to your organization.

You are a school system applying for exemption. While schools are exempt, school systems are not unless they have been granted a 501(c)(3) exemption by the Internal Revenue Service. If your system has received such an exemption, you may reapply and provide a copy of the 501(c)(3) exemption as documentation of your exempt eligibility.
