


<u>:</u> Go to schedule.hope.edu. Choose the correct term from the top dropdown menu. Then choose the attribute (see full list below) from which you will be pulling artifacts. The results of these menu options should be a list of courses that we need artifacts from, depending on the level of the courses (see note below).



Note: artifacts are needed from many courses only at a certain level (for example, the 100-level or the 200-level). If so, you should do a search as stated above for the appropriate attribute and then you'll have to look over the list and only use the courses that are numbered at the appropriate level.
