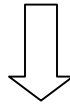


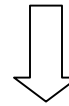
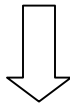

Eligibility: Applicants must demonstrate proficiency in the written language of the host country. (Applicants lacking a project may also be eligible.)



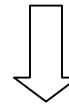
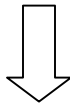
Defining a project: The study/research project is of sufficient academic merit and is feasible and necessitate a presence in the host country.

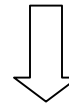
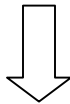
Enrolled students: Obtain application information from the campus Fulbright Program Adviser.

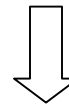
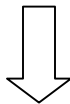


Enrolled students: Complete the application and forward it to the FPA by the campus deadline. (Enrolled students will also participate in campus review panels convened by the FPA.)

Applicants: Complete the application by the annual October deadline.

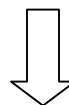
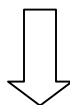


Applications are reviewed by Fulbright National Screening Committee panels (November –December).
